



TIMBER FENCES

Timber fences are probably the cheapest and most versatile forms of fencing. They can be made to any height* and there are many designs to suit your site and personal tastes. (*subject to by-laws)

Pine is the most commonly used fencing timber. Mr Fencer specifies only pine from inland forests which tends to have straighter grain than coastally grown timber and therefore is less prone to bowing.

Pine comes in different grades (the better ones clear of knots) and can be rough sawn (to be stained or left to weather naturally), or dressed (smoother for painting) so be sure to discuss all these aspects with us when planning your fence.

All posts and any other in-ground timber used by Mr Fencer is H-4 treated and above ground timber is H-3 treated for weather protection and durability.

Our standard practice includes fixed post-hole depths and concrete volume relative to fence height to minimise warping and bowing. Only rust-proof galvanised nails and fittings are used.

Be sure to check timber, hardware and construction specifications if you are comparing quotes from other suppliers.
