

TIMBER FENCE STYLES

The Edgcumbe - Rail Over

The Edgcumbe is a typical New Zealand suburban fence, with rails placed over posts and then finished with palings.

H4 ground treated posts 100 x 100 (no more than 2m apart), concreted in 800mm, 3 rails fixed to the backs of the posts and H3 palings 155x25mm. Inclusive of hardware including galvanised nails.

The Rumney

The Rumney is an affordable timber paling fence from the Mr Fencer range offering durability with a touch of class.

H3.2 capping rail, H4 ground treated posts 100 x 100 (no more than 2m apart), concreted in 800mm, 3 rails fixed to the backs of the posts and H3 palings 155x25mm cut in between posts. Inclusive of hardware including galvanised nails.

The Acoustic

The Acoustic is constructed with over lapping boards to increase noise reduction efficiency.

H3.2 capping rail, H4 ground treated posts 100 x 100 (no more than 2m apart), concreted in 800mm, 3 rails fixed to the backs of the posts and H3 palings 155x25mm cut in between posts with battens over joins. Inclusive of hardware including galvanised nails.

The Hamilton - Neighbour Friendly

The Hamilton is often referred to as the "Neighbour Friendly Fence". With every second panel alternating an attractive aspect is given to both sides of the fence.

H4 ground treated posts 100 x 100 (no more than 2m apart), concreted in 800mm, 3 rails fixed in between posts and H3 palings 155x25mm. Inclusive of hardware including galvanised nails.
